How to register?

Entries for the Competition will be made in the following days and time slots:

Opening of the registration platform on Wednesday 10 November 2021 from 12 p.m. GMT Closing of the registration platform on Sunday November 14, 2021 at 12 p.m. GMT.

Competition Rules:

The Competition will take place online through three steps, from November 16 (UNESCO's anniversary date) to November 30, 2021.

1st selection phase: open to all registrants, the competition will take place on Tuesday, November 16. Registration required in advance, deadline November 14 at 12:00 p.m.

2nd selection phase: for the top 20 participants from each country: Tuesday, November 23.

3rd selection phase: for the top 20 participants worldwide: Tuesday, November 30.

Concerning the 1st selection phase and the 2nd selection phase, you will have to answer a multiple choice question as follows:

- a) Five questions about the History of UNESCO (the main dates, the main texts and leading figures)
- b) Five questions about the UNESCO News (areas of competence, major programs and priorities)
- c) Five questions about the History and Current Affairs of the UNESCO Clubs Movement (key dates, organization and actions performed by the movement)

The 3rd selection phase of the Competition will include a fourth section entitled "Imagine your dream UNESCO". Each young person selected for this final phase will be able to prepare an original presentation in the format of their choice (video, slam, poetry, drawings, etc.).

Price:

All participants will get one-year access to many educational resources, thanks to our partner WhizJuniors. The three winners (aged 12 to 18) will receive 200 euros each. The three winners (aged 19 to 25) will receive 300 euros each. The six laureates will be invited to participate in the Prize-giving ceremony at UNESCO Headquarters, organized within the framework of the International Meeting of Youth of Clubs for UNESCO, scheduled for December 10, 2021, International Day of the Universal Declaration. of Human Rights (DUDH)..
